# Back ground of the Establishment of JANNET

- At the sectoral session on "International Cooperation" the members of around 20 relevant NGOs made their activity reports. And as a result they identified lack of information, financial and mam power resources.
- To jointly tackle the issues JANNET was established as a permanent network in December 1993 after its one year preparation period.
- Its initiators were Mr. Ryosuke Matsui, present Chairperson of JANNET (former Director of International Cooperation Department, Japan Organization for Employment Sopport of the Elderly, Persons with Disabilities and Job seekers) and Mr. Yoshinori Ikezumi formar Secretary General, Asian Health Institute(AHI).
